16.4 DCEU Requirements.

- a. Twelve (12) Deacon Continuing Education Units (DCEU) are required to be earned annually by deacons in Active Ministry. A DCEU is earned for each "contact hour" expended in the activity. A "contact hour" is defined as 45 to 60 minutes. A maximum of four (4) DCEUs may be earned by Self Study.
- b. One DCEU is earned for each contact hour for workshops, presentations, seminars, classes and lectures. If these cannot be attended in person and such activity has been electronically recorded, the same credit is granted for listening to the recordings. Conferences and other activities that take place during a retreat are not included since the retreat is a different diocesan requirement and these types of conferences and other retreat activities have a different focus.
- c. Two DCEUs are granted for each book that is read.
- d. One DCEU is granted for every two full length articles read in a journal, magazine, digest or review. Newspaper articles are not included
